

Adolescent outcomes of Post-operative opioid EXposure (APEX) Study

What is this study about?

- Our team wants to learn more about the use of pain medication in adolescents ages 12-17 who use pain medication after surgery.
- This study looks at individual characteristics to understand how they may affect recovery from surgery.

What to expect

- A study staff member will contact your family for an informational screening call.
- Adolescent participants and their parent/caregiver will be asked to complete a survey before surgery and then several more up to a year after surgery.
- Our team will collect information from the adolescent's medical record.



How to participate

Potentially eligible patients at participating medical centers will be contacted by study staff.
